REGULAR MEETING
MARCH 16, 2021**

The Oneonta City Board of Education met in regular session March 16, 2021, at 5:30 p.m. in the Oneonta High School Library. Members present were Don Maples, President, Patrick Adams, Ricky Hicks, Steve Anderton and Sharon Breaseale.

AGENDA APPROVED:

On a move from Mrs. Breaseale and a second from Mr. Anderton, the board unanimously approved the agenda.

On a move from Mr. Hicks and a second from Mrs. Breaseale, the board voted unanimously to move to executive session to discuss the good name and character of someone.


RECONVENE TO REGULAR SESSION:
