

**ONEONTA CITY BOARD OF EDUCATION
REGULAR MEETING
MARCH 31, 2022**

The Oneonta City Board of Education met in regular session March 31, 2022, at 5:30 p.m. in the Oneonta High School Library. Members present were Don Maples, President, Patrick Adams, Ricky Hicks, and Sharon Breaseale. Matthew Taylor was absent.

AGENDA APPROVED:

On a move from Mrs. Breaseale and a second from Mr. Hicks, the board unanimously approved the agenda.

MINUTES APPROVED:

On a move from Mrs. Breaseale and a second from Mr. Hicks the board unanimously approved the minutes of Regular Board Meeting February 28, 2022, and Special Called Meeting March 11, 2022.

FEBRUARY FINANCIAL STATEMENTS APPROVED:

On a move from Mr. Hicks and a second from Mr. Adams, the February financial statements were unanimously approved. The financial data and/or cash balances presented to the Board on March 31, 2022, are based on the reconciled bank statements to the general ledger as of February 28, 2022.

 - E. Approved the addition of a new CNP Cafeteria Manager position effective for the 2022-2023 school year.

On a move from Mrs. Breaseale and a second from Mr. Hicks, the board unanimously approved Superintendent Smith's recommendation 2.

2. Approved the English Language Arts textbook list vetted and recommended by the ALSDE for grades 4-12, also both CKLA Amplify and McGraw-Hill Open Court for K-3 for possible adoption at Oneonta City Schools.


