

**ONEONTA CITY BOARD OF EDUCATION
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
NOVEMBER 3, 2022**

The Oneonta City Board of Education met in a special called meeting November 3, 2022, at 7:00 a.m. at the Board of Education. Members present were Don Maples, Vice-President, Ricky Hicks, and Matthew Taylor. Patrick Adams and Sharon Breaseale were absent.

AGENDA APPROVED:

On a move from Mr. Hicks and a second from Mr. Taylor, the board unanimously approved the agenda.

SUPERINTENDENT RECOMMENDATIONS:

On a move from Mr. Hicks and a second from Mr. Taylor, the board unanimously approved Superintendent Sosebee's recommendations 1A, 2A through 2F, and 3.

1. Students
 - A. Approved the overnight field trip for the OHS Softball Team to Gulf Shores, AL, March 20 through 23, 2023.
2. Personnel
 - A. Accepted the resignation of Anna Marie Rainwater, OES 2nd grade Teacher, effective November 18, 2022.
 - B. Approved the employment of Mallory Gullede as OES 2nd grade Teacher, effective November 28, 2022, pending completion of degree and certification requirements.
 - C. Approved Thomas O'Barr for the position of OMS Long-term Substitute Teacher for 8th Grade History, effective November 18, 2022 to continue for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year.
 - D. Approved the maternity leave request for Heather Owens, OES 3rd Grade Teacher, from December 5, 2022 through February 27, 2023.
 - E. Approved the maternity leave request for Sarah Whitley, OES Speech Pathologist, from January 3 through March 17, 2023.
 - F. Approved Willie Dean Gaines as maternity leave substitute teacher for Sarah Whitley, OES Speech Pathologist.
3. Approved the purchased services contract with Milestones Behavioral Group for certified behavioral therapy services for the 2022-2023 school year to be paid by IDEA Preschool and State Preschool funds.

MOVE TO EXECUTIVE SESSION:

On a move from Mr. Taylor and a second from Mr. Hicks, the board unanimously voted to move to Executive Session to discuss a student disciplinary issue.

RECONVENE TO REGULAR SESSION:

On a move from Mr. Hicks and a second from Mr. Taylor, the board unanimously voted to reconvene to regular session.

SUPERINTENDENT RECOMMENDATION:

Superintendent Sosebee made the recommendation the student discussed in the executive session be placed in alternative placement with instruction provided from OMS through Schoology for a period of time to allow the student to complete a JPO fifteen-week program. Upon successful completion of the program, the board will re-evaluate the situation to determine if he/she will be allowed to return to the campus classroom. The student is to continue JBS counseling at an off-site location. During this time the student will not be allowed on campus or attend any school events on campus at home or away. If riding in the vehicle with the parent to transport a sibling to/from school, the student must remain in the vehicle at all times while on campus. On a move from Mr. Hicks and a second from Mr. Taylor the board unanimously approved Superintendent Sosebee's recommendation.
