The Oneonta City Board of Education met in a special called meeting August 12, 2020, at 8:00 a.m. in the Oneonta High School Library. Members present were Don Maples, President, Patrick Adams, Ricky Hicks, and Sharon Breaseale. Steve Anderton was absent.

**AGENDA APPROVED:**

On a move from Mrs. Breaseale and a second from Mr. Adams, the board unanimously approved the agenda.

**SUPERINTENDENT RECOMMENDATIONS:**

On a move from Mr. Adams and a second from Mr. Hicks the board unanimously approved Superintendent Smith's recommendations 1A through 1D.

1. Students
  - A. Approved the continued enrollment of two (2) OES non-resident students for the 2020-2021 school year.
  - B. Approved the continued enrollment of one (1) OES non-resident student on a probationary status for the first semester of the 2020-2021 school year.
  - C. Approved the continued enrollment of one (1) OMS non-resident student on a probationary status for the first semester of the 2020-2021 school year.
  - D. Approved the continued enrollment of one (1) OMS non-resident student on a probationary status for the first semester of the 2020-2021 school year.

3. Approved the new board policy #705.1 Supervision of Low Risk Juvenile Sex Offender.

Kathy Loggins reviewed the details for Budget hearing #1 for FY21. Another hearing will be held on August 31 before approval.

**SUPERINTENDENT REPORT:**

Superintendent Smith reported teachers began school on August 6 and have been busy learning new software platform; students start August 18. There are some issues facing us with COVID and currently 6 employees will miss the opening day for students. There has been a good response from employees on hybrid learning plan and they appreciate the board's recommendation. Lauren Wilson reported 23% of our students have opted to be full-time remote learners.

Superintendent Smith allowed Principal Rogers to introduce two (2) new OMS employees.

**BOARD REPORT:**

Mr. Adams requested an update on the state bond issue. Superintendent Smith stated ALSDE is looking at September or October to distribute money to schools.
