The Oneonta City Board of Education met in a special called meeting September 14, 2020, at 5:30 p.m. in the Oneonta High School Library. Members present were Don Maples, President, Patrick Adams, Ricky Hicks, Steve Anderton and Sharon Breaseale.

AGENDA APPROVED:

On a move from Mrs. Breaseale and a second from Mr. Hicks, the board unanimously approved the agenda.

BOARD RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Board voted for Beth Wilder for submission on the AASB District 9 Director ballot.

SUPERINTENDENT RECOMMENDATIONS:

On a move from Mr. Anderton and a second from Mr. Hicks the board unanimously approved Superintendent Smith's recommendation 1.

1. Approved the FY21 Capital Plan/Five Year Plan for Oneonta City School System.

SUPERINTENDENT REPORT:

Superintendent Smith provided an update on COVID cases and close contacts.
